► EMULSIFIABLE CONCENTRATE INSECTICIDE AGAINST FLYING AND CRAWLING INSECTS

Formulation: Emulsifiable concentrate (EC)

Active substance: Deltamethrin

Chemical family: Pyrethroid

Concentration: 2.87% w/w

Appearance: Yellow/transparent liquid

Target insects:

Flying insects (flies, mosquitoes,...)

Crawling insects (cockroaches, ants, spiders, bugs, scorpions, fleas...)

Mode of action:

The active substance Deltamethrin, belonging to the Pyrethroid chemical family acts by contact and ingestion. The molecule kills almost instantly by neurotoxic knockdown, blocking the transmission of nerve impulses.

Use instructions:

Determine the required amount of working liquid. Prepare solution a 5% solution. Apply by spraying at places where insects can hide. (Smooth or porous surfaces)

Application rate

Prepare a 5% solution by adding 1 litre of product to 20 litres of water.
This would cover an area of 400 square meters.

Intended uses:

Insecticide for professional use against crawling and flying insects such as flies, mosquitos and cockroaches for use on smooth and porous surfaces such as ceramic tiles and plywood.

Storage:

Keep out of reach of children. KEEP IN A SAFE PLACE.
Under these conditions, DELTA 2.5% EC can be stored for 2 years.

Packaging:

Empty the container thoroughly. Do not use the package again.
Disposal of empty containers should be done according to local and national regulations. Do not contaminate ponds/lakes, water pipes or ditches with the diluted product or with the empty container.

Precautions:

Wear protective clothing, gloves, goggles and a mask when handling and applying the product. Do not breathe spray.
Avoid excessive contamination of coveralls.
Wash contaminated clothing before reuse.
DO NOT CONTAMINATE FOODSTUFFS, EATING UTENSILS OR FOOD CONTACT SURFACES.

Cover or remove food before spraying.

First aid:


Contact with eyes - if the victim wears contact lenses, remove them. Flush eyes with plenty of cool water with eyelids open. Avoid strong stream of water, which can cause damage to the cornea. Consult with an ophthalmologist.

Contact with skin - Remove contaminated clothing, wash the affected skin with plenty of soap and water.

Ingestion - Do not induce vomiting. If the product gets into mouth, rinse them with water, which cannot be swallowed. If the product has been swallowed, get medical attention immediately.

Inhalation - remove to fresh air, limit physical activity. If not breathing, give artificial respiration and get medical attention immediately.
